



## Nomination requirements

- Each group leader (Assistant Professor/Associate Professor/Professor) can nominate one group member (PhD student/Postdoc) for a presentation slot in a parallel session.
- You are free to decide on the topic of the presentation. You can, for example, also use the overall theme of the conference 'The Element of Surprise'.
- All nominations should contain the following information:
  - Contact details group leader and nominee;
  - Title of the contribution (max. 8 words);
  - Keywords;
  - Abstract of the contribution (max. 200 words);
  - Main track (Chemistry of Life, Chemistry of Materials, Chemical Conversion, Fundamentals and Methods of Chemistry) the contribution fits best;
  - A primary, secondary and tertiary subtheme that fit the contribution;

### Submission instructions

1. Go to <https://online.nwochains.nl>
2. Create an account (last year's credentials are no longer valid). Please, do so by clicking on 'create one here' on the bottom right of the screen and fill in the required fields.
3. You can now log in with your new account and submit your abstract for the parallel session.

The nominations will be evaluated after the deadline per track by selection committees consisting of members of the programme committee and additional experts from the field. By the end of June or beginning of July, you will be informed by the decision of the programme committee regarding your nomination.
